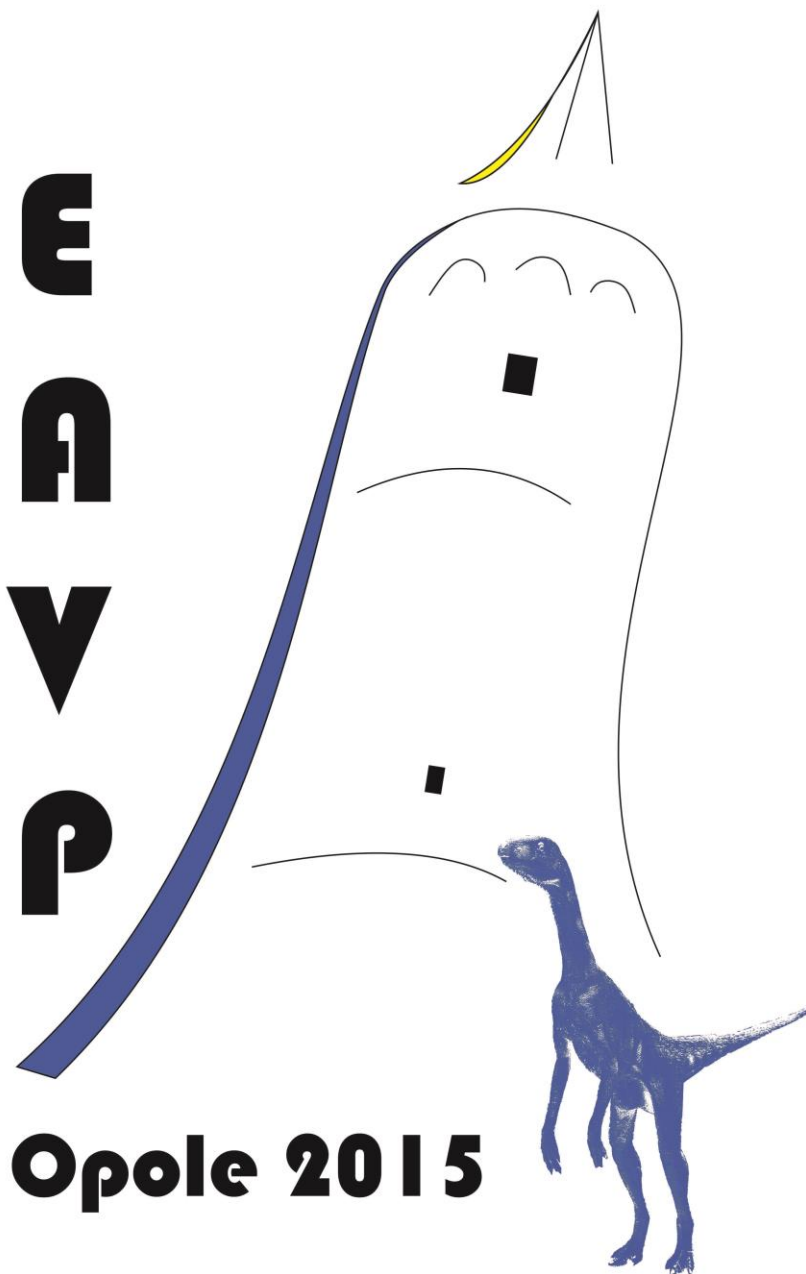

Dear Colleagues, EAVP members and Friends,

In view of the rapidly approaching Annual Meeting in Poland (i.e., in less than six months), the time is right to share some news with you.

1. Registration

The deadline for filling in the participation survey has already passed – unfortunately, only very few people returned the form to us.

However, we strongly believe that many more scientists wish to take part in this conference, which is why we kindly ask you to fill out the form of preliminary registration that is available online (www.eavp2015.uni.opole.pl). Please note: **in order to make registration easier, we hereby extend the deadline to March 15**, which means that you can now submit the **abstract** and the filled-out form together. Please do before the deadline of March 15, to help us with funding and determine the number of participants more accurately.

2. Call for abstracts – this will open on February 8. Abstracts may be submitted online (www.eavp2015.uni.opole.pl) or sent via e-mail to: paleontologia@uni.opole.pl

The abstract (in English) should clearly outline the importance of the research in the field of vertebrate palaeontology and contain aim, results and conclusions. The format should be the following:

1. Title (maximum 150 characters, including spaces)
2. Author(s), with (all) affiliation(s)
3. E-mail address of corresponding author
4. Body of abstract - no more than 250 words; do not include references or figures.

4. Transmitting Science Grant

Transmitting Science (<http://www.transmittingscience.org/>) will provide a 250 € grant for PhD students or Postdocs (under 40 years old) presenting an oral communication at the meeting related to one of the following topics: Functional Morphology, Ecomorphology, Phylogenetic Comparative Analysis, Histology, Biogeography, Paleoecology or Geometric Morphometrics. 5. Workshop on geometric morphometrics

Saturday, June 11, in the morning a workshop on geometric morphometrics will be staged. If you wish to participate in this, please fill in the proper place on the registration form. The number of places is limited to only 30 people (decided the registration order).

6. PALEOART session – Opole 2015

The Organising Committee of XIIIth Meeting of the EAVP (European Association of Vertebrate Palaeontologists) invite you to take part in a special session dedicated to palaeontological artistic reconstructions, PALEOART – Opole 2015.

The main goals of the session are:

1. Presentation of palaeontological reconstructions
2. Presentation of artistic profiles
3. Co-operation between people from scientific and artistic domains.

An award for the best work is expected to be presented by a jury of scientists and artists.
